Brief History of the Jesuits

- ► Founded in 1540 by Ignatius of Loyola
- Known for education and missionary work worldwide

Ignatius of Loyola's Vision

- Ignatius founded the Society to serve the Pope
- ► Focused on spiritual exercises and loyalty to the Church

Global Reach of Jesuit Schools

- Jesuit schools operate in over 100 countries worldwide, impacting diverse cultures and societies.
- Over 2 million students are enrolled in Jesuit schools globally, fostering a global community of learners.

Values-Based Education

Jesuit education emphasizes ethical values such as social justice, compassion, and service to others.

Jesuit Institutions in INDIA

Today, in India the Jesuits conduct not less than

- > 408 Schools
- 62 University Colleges
- > 22 Technical Institutes
- > 16 Business Administrations Institutes
- > 4 Universities

with

- > 11,525 teachers
- educating 3,34,538 students

belonging to every social class, community, linguistic and socio-economic group, receive their education.

Structure of the Federation of JAAI (estd. in 1958)

JAAI Council

A representative from each province, National advisor, WUJA Council members from JAAI & Province Coordinators for Alumni (PCAs), Patron and permanent invitees form the Governing Council of JAAI.



The Zonal Council

comprises of three representatives from each province and PCAs. The zonal congresses are usually organized six months before the National Congress which are held every three years
