Based on above, Eco-Club Baseline Survey launched in Jul/Aug 24 in which 27 Schools from 4 provinces participated.

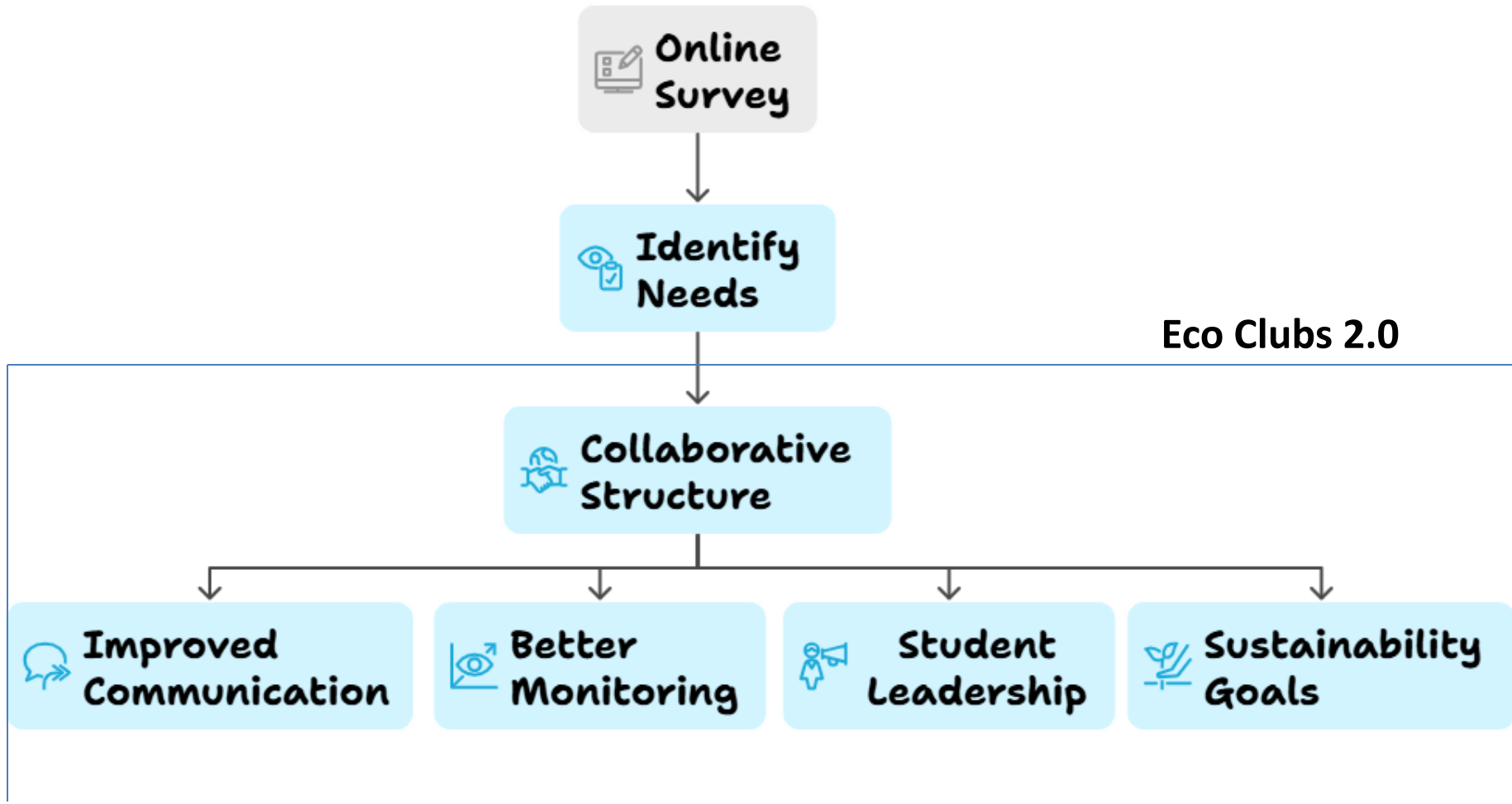

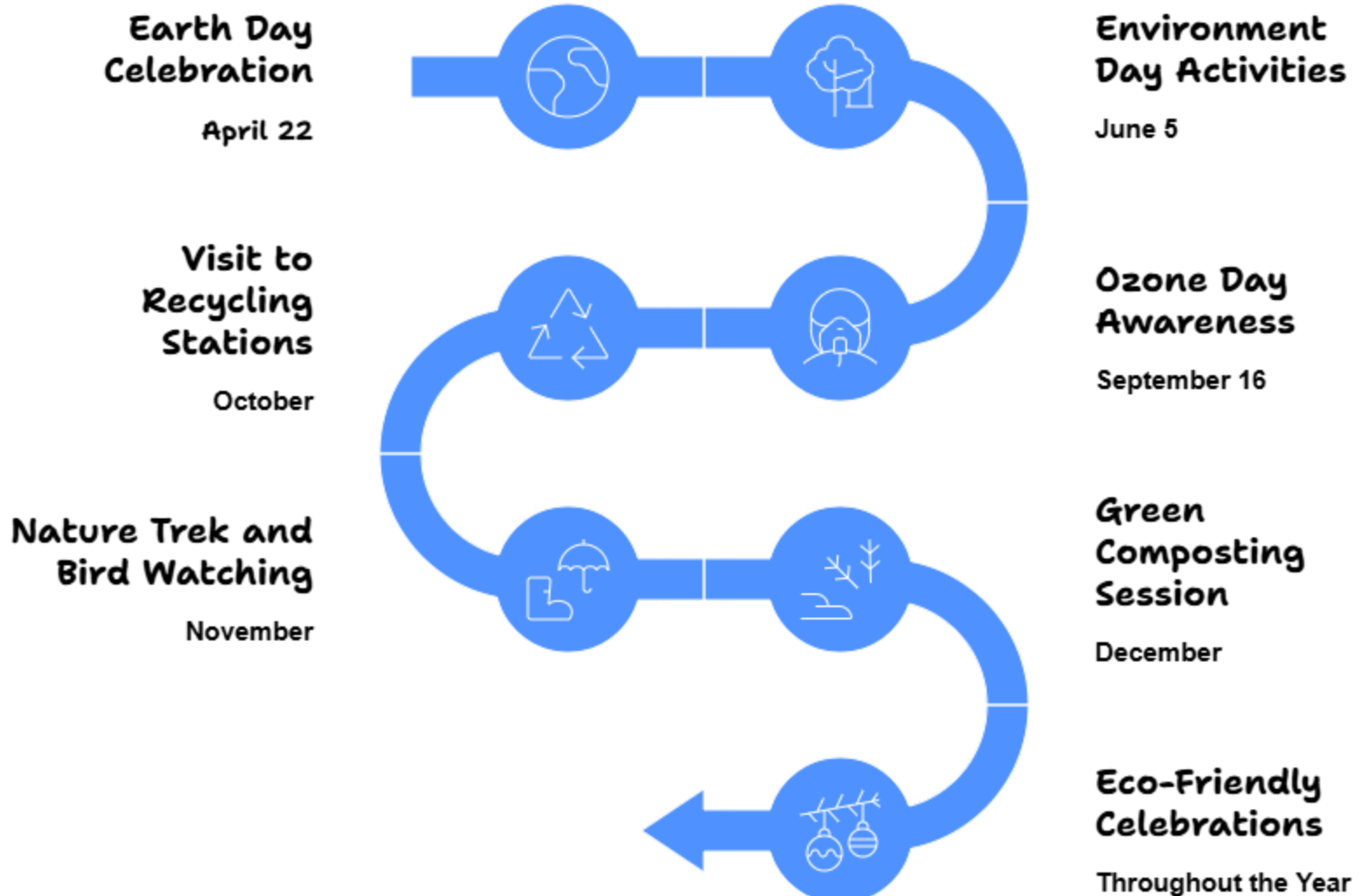

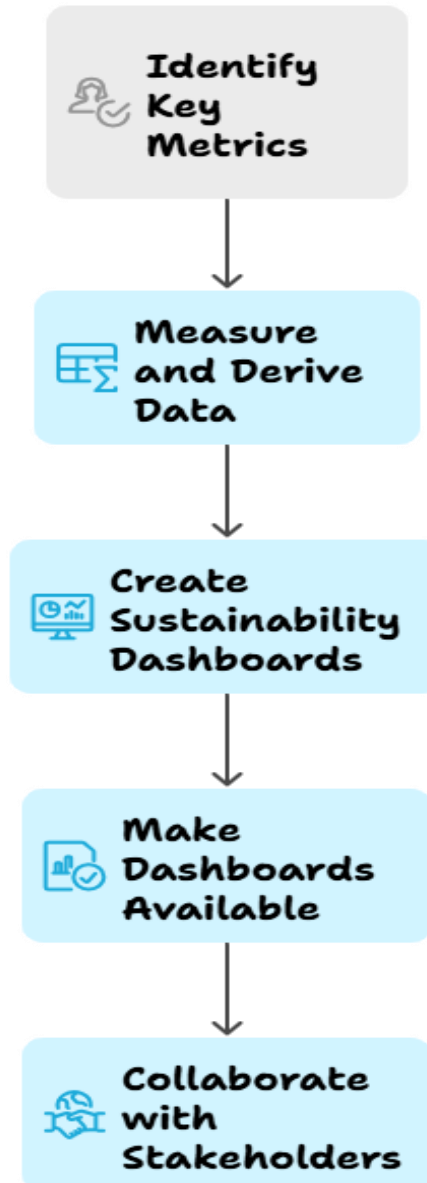

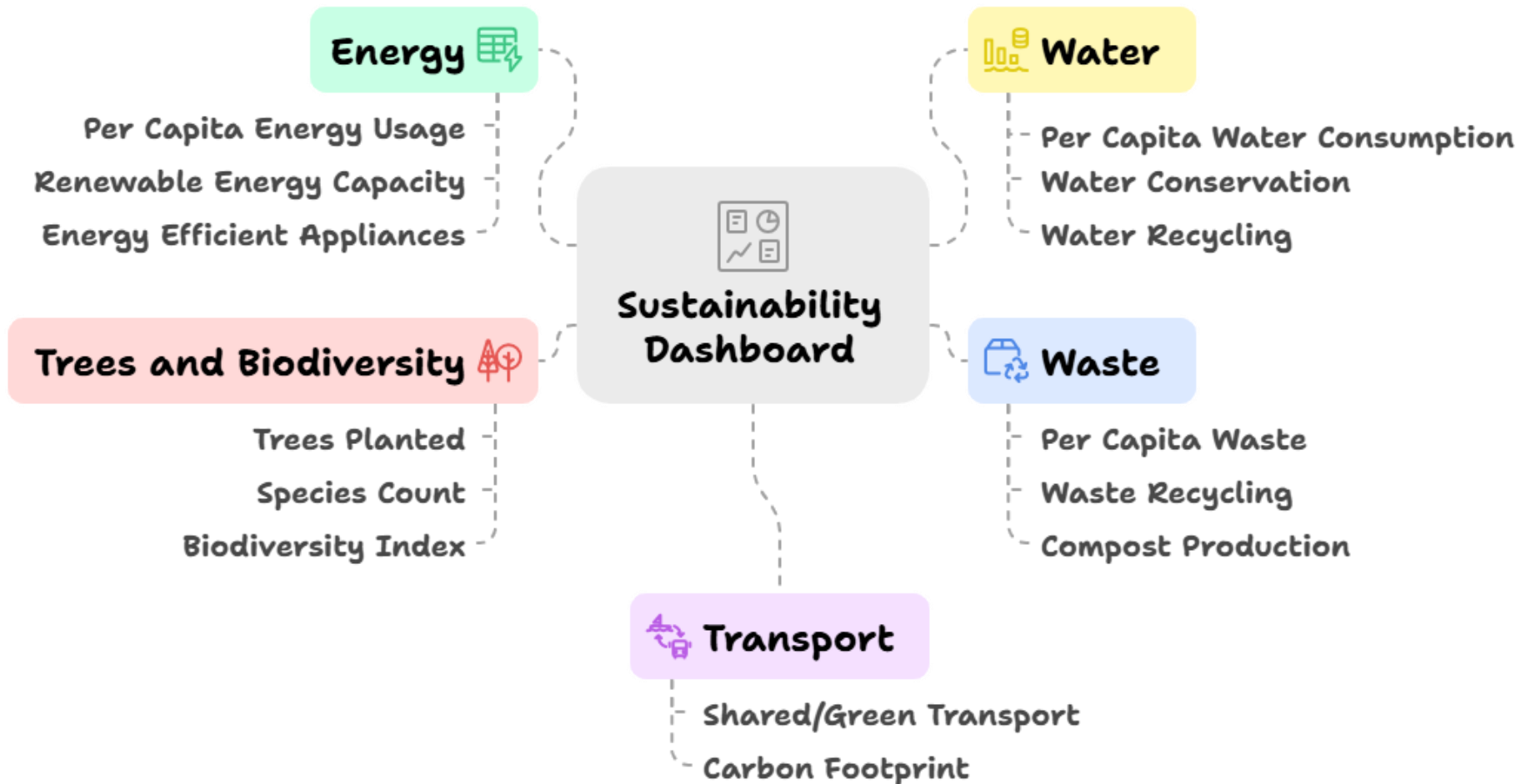
